Alejandro Aravena received his degree from Universidad Catolica in 1992. He is executive director of ELEMENTAL, a “do-tank” that, in partnership with the Chilean Oil Company COPEC and Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, develops housing and infrastructural projects with public interest and social impact. He was the visiting Professor at the Graduate School of Design of Harvard University between 2000. Since 2009, he has been a member of the Pritzker Prize jury. In 2010 he was named International Fellow of the Royal Institute of Architects. His awards include the Silver Lion of the Venice Biennale (2008) and the Index Award in Denmark (2011) and most recently the Zumtobel Global Award (2014),

Alejandro has been named one of the 20 new heroes of the world by Monocle magazine and the recipient of the Marcus Prize 2009, celebrating young architects of outstanding promise and talent. He is currently member of the advisory boards of the David Rockefeller Center for Latin American Studies and of the Cities Program of the London School of Economics

His work includes buildings for Universidad Catolica (Mathematics School, Medical School, Architecture School, Siamese Towers for Digital Technology and more recently the Angelini Innovation Center), St. Edwards University in Austin, Texas, a Children Workshop and Chairless for Vitra, a building for Novartis in their new campus in China, the Metropolitan Promenade and Children’s Park in Santiago, the reconstruction of the city of Constitucion after the 2010 earthquake, the redesign of the Copper mining town of Calama and a wide range of social housing projects in Chile and abroad starting in 2004 with Quinta Monroy, the first case following the principles established by Elemental for incremental housing.
